Solution Dyed Acrylic fabrics should be cleaned regularly before substances such as dirt & food particles are allowed to accumulate on & become embedded in the fabric. Although Solution Dyed Acrylic fabrics do not promote mildew growth, mildew may grow on dirt or on other foreign substances that may accumulate after extended use. Do not allow cushions to sit damp or wet for long periods without drying.

Hand washable. Do NOT dryclean.

WASHING INSTRUCTIONS

Remove hooks, rings & trims before cleaning. Possible shrinkage 3-5%. Hand Wash in Luke Warm water. Use mild washing liquid like "Softly" or "Woolite". Do Not use regular washing powders with Optical Whiteners or Oxidizing agents. Do not clean with hot water extraction machine.

SPOT CLEANING

* Always test an inconspicuous area before proceeding.

The fabric can be cleaned without being removed from the furniture by simply brushing off any loose dirt & sponging with a solution of mild soap & luke warm water. Rinse thoroughly with clean water. Do not wet filling with water or other cleaning liquid. Allow to dry before re-use. Some colour variation may occur if cushions are cleaned separately from main covers. Do not shampoo clean. Do not clean with hot water extraction machine.

REGULAR CARE

Do not allow dust to accumulate. Vacuum curtains and upholstery regularly (low suction) using vacuum brush attachment. Rotate reversible cushions regularly.

PILLING

Can occur occasionally as a result of normal daily wear & should not be considered as a fault. Fibre pills can be removed by a battery operated pilling tool available from most haberdashery stores.

CAUTION

Before applying Stain Repellent finish (Water based fabric treatments only) or any other finishes, Always Test a sample or an inconspicuous area before proceeding. These finishes can change the appearance of the fabric. Also check that fabric has not already been treated by the mill.

- Hand Washable.
- Do Not Dryclean.
- Cool Iron.
- Do Not Tumble Dry.
